

**NEWBURGH SEA CREATURES
OPEN TIME TRIALS**

- SANCTION:** This meet is sanctioned by USA Swimming and Indiana Swimming. Sanction #IN10358.
- HOST:** Newburgh Sea Creatures, Inc.

- LOCATION:** Castle High School

- FACILITIES:** Competition Pool: 50 meter by 25 yard pool. Competition will be conducted in 8 lanes with additional lane for warm up and warm down throughout meet. Competition non-turbulent lane markers. State of the art Daktronics timing system with electronic take-off platforms. Seating area for over 500.
- The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). The copy of such certification is on file with USA Swimming.
- Pool depth at 1 meter from starting blocks measures 2 meters deep and depth at 5 meters from starting blocks measures 5 meters deep in accordance with 103.2.3.
- TYPE OF MEET:** This is an open time trial, **CARDED** meet. All events are Long Course Meters.
- ENTRIES:** Entry deadline is the day of the meet (no pre-meet entries will be accepted) Entries for new swimmers will close at 11:00am. All swimmers must obtain entries at Clerk of Course on the day of the Meet. Swimmers are limited to a maximum of five trials.
- RULES:** Current USA Swimming and Indiana Swimming rules will govern the Time Trials. USA Swimming Rules 202.3.2 – At a sanctioned competitive event, USA Swimming athlete members must be under the supervision of a USA Swimming member coach during warm-up, competition, and warm-down. The Meet Director or Meet Referee shall assist the athlete in making arrangements for such supervision. Swimmer(s) must be registered with USA Swimming to be accepted into this meet. Age as of July 11, 2010 shall determine the swimmer's age for the Time Trials.
- In swimming competitions, the competitor must wear only one swimsuit in one or two pieces except as provided in 205.10.1. All swimsuits shall be made from textile materials. For men, the swimsuit shall not extend above the navel nor below the knees, and for women, shall not cover the neck, extend past the shoulder, nor extend below the knee.

AWARDS/SCORING: No awards or scoring will be conducted at this event.

ENTRY FEE: Fees are \$5.00 per event and are payable at Clerk of Course. Each athlete will pay an Indiana Swimming \$1.50 per athlete surcharge. Check must be made payable to Newburgh Sea Creatures.

ENTRY LIMITS: Swimmers may swim a maximum of five trials. They may enter five separate events, swim a single event five times, or a combination totaling five entries.

CONCESSIONS: Limited concessions including snacks and drinks will be available.
